




Gotta cost a lot though.

Genuine, beautiful, intimate, and at times soft-spoken, *Leftovers* is like something you'd find on a floppy disc after the world ends and you're



Marsico's vocals remind me a bit of the soft almost-whispery vibes of Alex G and Elliott Smith, though it doesn't feel like he's trying to emulate anyone other than himself. And with his ability to sing all whisper-like it's no surprise he also makes ASMR videos on youtube (with titles like alien toxic relationship ASMR (kissing, fight scene, pregnancy)), which, if you're fortunate enough to have that special asmr reaction or just enjoy listening to that kind of thing, you should definitely check out. Instrumentally Marsico keeps things simple, which highlights his lyrics and guitar talent and makes the album feel all the more personal.




